BÒRD NA GÀIDHLIG CUR TAIC RI RADIO MÒD

09 An Dàmhair 2009

Tha Bòrd na Gàidhlig air taic a thoirt do Radio Mòd a bhith a' craoladh am bliadhna bhon Mhòd Rìoghail Nàiseanta anns an Òban. Tha am Mòd a' toiseachadh anns an Òban a nochd (Dihaoine, Dàmhair 9) agus bidh Murchadh Moireasdan agus an sgioba aige a-rithist a' craoladh fad sheachdain an tachartais, a' cur ri craoladh eile a bhios air a thairgse leis a' BhBC tro thelebhisein agus Radio nan Gàidheal.

Thuirt Art MacCarraig, Cathraiche a' Bhùird: "Tha sinn air leth toilichte taic a thoirt do Mhurchadh agus an Sgioba aige airson a bhith a' craoladh fad sheachdain a' Mhòid. Tha fhios again gum bi na milltean de Ghàidheil a' cruinneachadh dhan Òban thar na seachdain seo tighinn, ach tha gu leòr eile ann nach faigh chun bhaile, agus 's dòcha nach urrainn a bhith a' leantainn chùisean còmhla ris a' BhBC. 'S e goireas air leth feumail a tha Murchadh agus a chuideachd a' tairgse dhan Mhòd agus tha sinn gu math toilichte gun deach againn air an cuideachadh am bliadhna airson na seirbheisean seo a fhrithealadh."

Bidh taghadh de phrògraman aig Murchadh agus an sgioba fad na seachdain agus iad a' craoladh bho stiùidios Oban FM ann am meadhan a' bhaile. Bidh Sgioba taic còmhla ri Murchadh bo Radio Coimhearsnachd Bharraigh. Thuirt esan: "Tha e gu math feumail is na thaic dhuinne gu bheil a leithid gu bhith comhla ruin am bliadhna agus bidh e 'na chuideachadh dhaibh fhèin gu bheil iad a' faighinn leithid de chothrom an cuid eòlais a thogail. Tha fhios againn gu robh co-dhiù dà stèisean coimhearsnachd a bha a' craoladh an stuth againn fad an latha an uiridh, agus bidh e an urra riutha fhèin dè na bhios iad a' gabhail. BÒRD NA GÀIDHLIG TO SUPPORT RADIO MOD

09 October 2009

Bòrd na Gàidhlig has helped set up Radio Mòd this year to broadcast from the Royal National Mod in Oban. The Mòd opens in Oban tonight (Friday 9 October) and Murdo Morrison and his team will be broadcasting at the event all of Mod week, adding to other broadcast material being offered by the BBC both through television and Radio nan Gàidheal.

Art Cormack, Chair of Bòrd na Gàidhlig, said: “We are delighted to offer support to Murdo and his team to broadcast throughout all of Mod week. I know that thousands of Gaels will be gathering in Oban over the coming week, but at the same time there are lots of people who will not be able to attend the event, and perhaps are also unable to follow the course of events with the BBC. Murdo and his team are providing the Mod with a resource which is particularly useful and, therefore, we are very happy that we have managed to help them in order to provide these services.”

Murdo and his team will run a choice of programmes during the whole of the week, and they will be broadcasting from the studios of Oban FM in the centre of the town. There will be a supporting team with Murdo from Barra Community Radio. He said: “It is so useful and supportive to us to have such a team with us this year, and it will be helpful to them also to receive an opportunity to put their experience into practice. We know that there were at least two community stations broadcasting our programmes on a day-long daily basis last year, and it is up to them as to the amount they wish to take on. The programmes can also be accessed on the internet but I do hope that we will have a large audience listening in on 103.3m and we shall be working along with Oban FM. I hope that people will call in to see us as the week progresses, so that we can add to the news items which we will be broadcasting daily.”
