BÒRD NA GÀIDHLIG A' CUR TAIC RI FOILLSEACHADH DVD DO PHÀRANTAN IS OIGRIDH

12 An Dàmhair 2009

Le taic bho Bhòrd na Gàidhlig, tha Comhairle Earra-Ghàidheal is Bhòid air DVD a thoirt gu buil gus taic a thoirt do phàrantan agus do dhaoine òga a tha ag ionnsachadh Gàidhlig.

Tha an DVD, a tha air a dheasachadh airson aois 0-3 ro-sgoile agus air a dhealbhadh le Mòr Media agus Sealladh Tbh, a' nochdadh pupaid fon ainm "Cabag" a bhios san Raon Cluiche-bog ann an Atlantis Leisure anns an Òban eadar 1:00 agus 1:30 Diluain 12 Dàmhair, a' chiad latha de Mhòd na cloinne.

BÒRD NA GÀIDHLIG SUPPORTS DVD LAUNCH

A new DVD to support parents and young children who are learning Gaelic has been produced by Argyll & Bute Council with support from Bòrd na Gàidhlig.

The DVD, which is aimed at the 0-3 pre-school age group, was compiled by Mor Media and Sealladh TV, features a puppet, "Cabag" who will be at Atlantis Leisure's Soft Play Area, between 1:00 and 1:30 on Monday 12th October, the first day of the children's Mod in Oban.

Parents and children who come along to the Atlantis Centre will be entertained by Cabag as she sings songs and tells stories before then having a chat with the children. There will also be an opportunity to see clips of the DVD which will be distributed to Gaelic schools nationally at the beginning of next year, in time for them to be issued to parents who will be registering their children for Gaelic Education.

Rosemary Ward, Bòrd na Gàidhlig's Director of Education and Learning said: "The pre-school sector is vital for our continuing interest in developing and delivering a new generation of Gaelic speakers. This is a particularly imaginative use of our GLAIF funding which Argyll and Bute Council has used to good effect and it could elad to further spin-offs through written material and in other directions. I would encourage parents with young children to come to Atlantis to see what is on offer and I am sure that cabag will be extremely popular among our younger audiences at the start of Mod week. Who knows, she may well have something to say to parents as well."
