Tha Colmcille – prògram com-pàirteachais a tha ag adhartachadh an dualchais chànanach is chultarach eadar Èirinn is Alba – a' cur taic ris an t-sianal telebhisean Gaeilge TG4 gus mothachadh leantainneach a thogail mun bheatha làitheil ann an coimhearsnachdan Gàidhlig na h-Alba. Tro thaic maoinneachaidh bho Cholmcille, tha prìomh phrògram naidheachdan làitheil TG4 a' craoladh naidheachdan sònraichte gach seachdain bho BBC Alba, le fo-thotalain ann an Gaeilge. Thuirtear Iar-Cheannard TG4, Pádhraic Ó Ciardha, "Tha sinn a' creidsinn gu bheil tuigse agus ùidh aig a' choimhearsnachd Ghaeilge ann an Èirinn agus sa Ghaeltacht anns a' choimhearsnachd Ghàidhlig ann an Alba. Tha ar luchd-èisteachd a' tuigsinn nan dùbhlannan mu choinneamh coimhearsnachd mhion-chànan a' dìon cultar is beatha ann an coimhearsnachdan dùthchail iomallach, agus tha an iomairt seo gus cuideachadh le barrachd tuigse a bhrosnachadh air saidhbhreas na Gàidhlig agus air a' chultar co-cheangailte rithe." COLMCILLE SUPPORTS TV STATION TO PROMOTE THE SHARED CULTURAL HERITAGE OF IRELAND AND SCOTLAND

Colmcille – a partnership programme which promotes the shared linguistic and cultural heritage of Ireland and Scotland – supports the Irish language television channel TG4 to promote continued awareness of daily life in Scotland’s Gaelic communities. Through financial support from Colmcille, TG4’s flagship daily news programme broadcasts a special weekly news feature from BBC Alba, which is subtitled in Gaeilge. TG4 Deputy CEO, Pádhraic Ó Ciardha said that “We believe that the Irish speaking community in Ireland and in the Gaeltacht have an understanding and interest in the Gaelic-speaking community of Scotland. Our audience understand the challenges facing a minority language community, the preservation of culture and life in remote rural communities and this initiative assists to further understand the richness of the Scottish Gàidhlig language and its associated culture.” Colmcille celebrates and promote mutual awareness and positive interaction among the Gaelic communities in Ireland and Scotland.
