

## Bliadhna shònraichte aig Bòrd na Gàidhlig

Tha Bòrd na Gàidhlig air an Aithisg Bhliadhnailear airson na bliadhna ionmhais 2012/13 a chur fa chomhair Pàrlamaid na h-Alba; bliadhna shònraichte anns an do dh'fhoillsich am Bòrd an dàrna Plana Càinain Nàiseanta Gàidhlig. Chaidh am plana fhoillseachadh leis An Dr Alasdair Allan, am Ministear airson Ionnachsaidh, Saidheans agus Cànanan na h-Alba.

Tha an Aithisg a' cur cuideam air an àite a bh' aig a' Bhòrd a' cuideachadh ann a bhith toirt gu buil amasan a' Phlana agus sin le iad fhèin a bhith a' libhrigeadh sheirbheisean taice dha Roinn nan Tràth Bhliadhnaichean, le bhith cur air adhart cultar agus foghlam Gàidhlig; cuideachd le bhith toirt comhairle agus taic airgid agus phractaigeach dha coimhairsnachdan, buidhnean agus daoine fa leth air feadh Alba.

Tha am Plana a' toirt priomhachas dhan Dachaigh agus Tràth-bhliadhnaichean, Foghlam agus adhartachadh cànan sa Choimhairsnachd agus e aig an aon àm a' cur ro-innleachdan air chois a dh'fhaodas buidhnean poblach agus a h-uile duine a tha an sàs ann, no aig a bheil ùidh, an leasachadh na Gàidhlig a leantainn airson taic a thoirt dhan chànan.

A' toirt beachd air na chaidh a choileanadh, mar a tha e san aithisg, thuit Ceannard Bòrd na Gàidhlig, Iain Aonghas MacAoidh: "S e buidheann bheag a tha seo le uallaichean mòra. Bha na choilean sinn am-bliadhna ann a bhith toirt buaidh air dùblain agus a' greimeachadh air cothroman stèidhichte air cho dicheallach 's a bha am Bòrd is an Luchd-obrach, agus an co-obrachadh agus an dealas a bha ri fhaicinn bho cheudan de bhuidhnean agus dhaoine fa leth leis a bheil sinn ag obair – raon farsaing bho Phàrlamaid is Riaghaltas agus Ùghdarrasan Poblach, an treas raon agus buidhnean coimeirsealta gu ruige coimhairsnachdan ionadail. Bidh cho soirbheachail 's a bhios Plana Càinain Nàiseanta Gàidhlig an crochadh gu mòr aig deireadh an latha air mar a thèid na h-oidhirpean sin a chloileanadh."

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Tha 73% den airgead a gheibh am Bòrd bho Riaghaltas na h-Alba air a roinn a-mach gu luchd com-pàirt eile. Dhèilig am Bòrd ri 362 iarrtas airson taic-airgid bho chaochladh bhuidhnean air feadh Alba, ged nach robh iad uile soirbheachail, a thoradh cuingealachdan ionmhaisail, agus laigsean seach nach robh iad a' dol le amasan Plana Càinain Nàiseanta Gàidhlig. Chaith aontachadh ri 258 iarrtasan. (Chithear gu ìosal na seòrsachan iarrtasan a bha soirbheachail)

Thuirt am Ministear airson Chànanan na h-Alba Alasdair Allan: "Tha am Bòrd air targaidean soilleir a chur far comhair airson nam bliadhnaichean ri teachd a tha sealltainn am miann airson adhartais, targaidean a bheir dhuinn tachartasan Gàidhlig agus cothroman ionnsachaidh air feadh Alba. Tha obair a chaidh a dhèanamh o chionn ghoirid air dearbhadh gu soilleir an ìre ùidhe a th' ann agus mar a tha an t-iarrtas a' fàs airson Gàidhlig agus a' sealltainn an àite fior chudromach a th' aice ann am beatha làitheil dhaoine agus mar a tha i na bonn-stèidh do ar cultar agus ar n-aithne mar shluagh."

Thuirt Cathraiche Bòrd na Gàidhlig, Iain Caimbeul: "'S e bhith foillseachadh Plana Càinain Nàiseanta Gàidhlig 2012/17 an rud bu chudromaiche a thachair am-bliadhna. Tha mi toilichte gun urrainn dhuinn sealltainn anns an Aithisg seo gun do rinn am Bòrd agus buidhnean com-pàirt adhartas cudromach ann a bhith a' toirt a' Phlana gu buil agus sin le bhith cuimseachadh ar gnìomhan air na prìomhachasan as cudromaiche."

## Landmark year for Bòrd na Gàidhlig

Bòrd na Gàidhlig has presented to the Scottish Parliament its Annual Report for the 2012/13 financial year, a landmark year in which the Bòrd published Scotland's 2nd National Gaelic Language Plan. The Plan was launched by the Minister for Learning, Science and Scotland's Languages, Dr Alasdair Allan.

The Report highlights the Bòrd's role in facilitating the delivery of the Plan's objectives through providing support services directly to the Early Years sector, promoting Gaelic education and culture and by providing advice, financial and practical support to communities, organisations and individuals throughout Scotland.

The Plan prioritises Home and Early Years, Education and Community language development, whilst setting out strategies for public agencies and all those involved with, and interested in, Gaelic development to follow in support of the language.

Reflecting on the achievements outlined in the report, Bòrd na Gàidhlig Ceannard (CEO), John Angus MacKay said: "This is a small organisation with heavy responsibility. Our success in meeting challenges and grasping opportunities this year was based on a combination of dedication by our Bòrd and Staff, and the co-operation and diligence of the hundreds of organisations and individuals with which we work - ranging from Parliament and Government and Public Authorities, third sector and commercial organisations through to local communities. The success of the National Gaelic Language Plan will be determined ultimately by the outcomes of these contributions."

73% of the funding received by the Bòrd from Scottish Government is distributed to others. The Bòrd dealt with 362 applications for funding from different organisations throughout the length and breadth of Scotland, although not all were successful due to funding constraints and weaknesses in alignment to the National Gaelic Language Plan. 258 applications were approved. (Categories of successful applications are

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enumerated below)

Minister for Scotland's Languages Alasdair Allan said: "The Bòrd has set out clear and ambitious targets for the coming years that will deliver Gaelic events and learning opportunities across Scotland. Recent work has clearly demonstrated the level of interest and the growing demand for Gaelic and shows its role as a vital part of people's everyday lives as well as a lynchpin in our culture and identity."

Bòrd na Gàidhlig Cathraiche (Chair), Iain Campbell said: "The launch of the National Gaelic Language Plan 2012/17 was the single most significant event of the year. I am pleased that we are able to demonstrate in this Report that the Bòrd and partner organisations made significant progress towards the implementation of the Plan through focusing our actions on key priorities."

- **68** - community projects funded through the Taic Freumhan Coimhersnachd (Community Support funding scheme)

- **72** - projects funded through the GLAIF (Gaelic Language Act Implementation Fund) funding scheme to support Public Bodies' Gaelic Language Plans
- **20** - projects funded through our different Arts funds
- **11** - Research projects funded
- **35** - 0-3 age Groups funded

- **4.2%** - efficiency savings found against Government target of 3%
- **85%** - KPIs achieved
- **9/15** - of the National Outcomes in the Scottish Government's National Performance Framework contributed to
