Bòrd na Gàidhlig, the principal body responsible for the promotion and development of Gaelic, has signalled next week's launch of BBC ALBA on Freeview Channel 8 as "an immensely significant and crucial contribution to the revitalisation and normalisation of Gaelic in Scotland".

The Bòrd has worked constructively with the MG ALBA, the BBC, and the BBC Trust over the last year to secure access for BBC ALBA viewers to Freeview.

Bòrd na Gàidhlig Ceannard, John Angus MacKay, said that "this is the only Gaelic television service available in the UK and its launch on Freeview will allow so many more people to enjoy access to the Gaelic language. BBC ALBA is just one element of a series of important linkages across media platforms which have evolved significantly in the last few years and it has laid the groundwork for further development and sustainable growth in the number of Gaelic speakers in Scotland".

"Bòrd na Gàidhlig will be launching a new National Plan for Gaelic this Autumn, and the very welcome move of BBC ALBA on to Freeview next week will be critical to supporting our primary aim of increasing the number of Gaelic speakers, as well as embracing all the work happening in Gaelic pre-school education; education in schools, colleges and universities; the ever increasing opportunities for adults to learn the language; and Gaelic arts activities throughout Scotland."
