Pròiseactan a gheibhear taic

Clàr-ama a' Phròiseict

Bidh an sgeama a' toirt taic do phròiseactan a thèid an tòiseachadh eadar 1 Giblean 2021 agus 31 Màrt 2022 agus a thèid crìochnachadh ro 31 Lùnastal 2022. Tha taic cuideachd ri fhaighinn do dhaoine airson cùrsa Gaeilge a dhèanamh sa bhliadhna-ionmhais 2021/22.

The aim of this fund is to support community projects and individuals in both Scotland and Ireland that help enrich, use and strengthen Gaelic and Irish by working in partnership.

Projects this fund aims to support

This year's scheme would specifically like to support projects that achieve the following:

- Supporting Gaelic and Irish usage through the arts
- Using heritage to bring Gaelic and Irish communities together to promote the status of the languages
- Bringing young Gaelic and Irish speakers together through events or school projects
- Promoting communication and sharing of knowledge and best practice among Gaelic and Irish speakers
- Supporting the learning of Irish among Gaelic speakers

All projects must also consider how their work can contribute to the celebrations and commemorations as part of [the Year of Colmille 1500](#).

Project Requirements

Who can apply?

This fund is open to constituted organisations based in Scotland or Ireland that hope to deliver a project linking together Gaelic and Irish communities.

Individuals who are looking to undertake Irish classes or courses can also apply through our dedicated form.

Project Timeframe

The fund will support projects which will start between 1 April 2021 and 31 March 2022 and will be fully completed by 31 August 2022. Support is also available for those looking to take an Irish course in the 2021/22 financial year.

Ìrean taic-airgid

Faodar iarrtasan airson cursaichean Gaeilge suas ri **£400** sireadh, no suas ri **£600** airson oileanaich lan-thide, no dhaoine gun obair no gun tuarastal.

- Cho dlùth 's a tha am pròiseact a' freagairt ri prìomhachasan na maoine
- Comas am buidheann agaibh am pròiseact libhrigeadh gu soirbheachail
- Neart nam planaichean agaibh gus buaidh a' phròiseict agaibh a mheasadh
- Luach an airgid a tha ga shealltainn leis a' phròiseict

Funding levels

Project applications may be made for up to a maximum of **£12,500** and **up to 80% of project costs**.

Applications for Irish course support can request up to **£400**, or **£600** for full-time students, or those that are unemployed or unwaged.

Assessing your application

In assessing project applications, we will be primarily looking at:

- The quality of the project and the applicant
- How clearly the project demonstrates a connection with the fund's priorities
- The ability of your organisation to deliver the project successfully
- The strength of your plans to assess the impact of your project
- The value for money demonstrated by the project
