

Maoin Buileachaidh Achd na Gàidhlig (GLAIF) 2021/22

Chaidh Maoin Buileachaidh Achd na Gàidhlig (GLAIF) a stèidheachadh airson ùghdarrasan poblach a chuideachadh gus na Planaichean Gàidhlig aca a chur an gnìomh agus taic a chur ris a' Phlana Cànain Nàiseanta Ghàidhlig. Tha ùghdarrasan poblach cuideachd air taic-airgid fhaighinn tro GhLAIF gus pròiseactan a thoirt gu buil mus fhaigh iad fios foirmeil Plana Gàidhlig a sgrìobhadh.

The Gaelic Language Act Implementation Fund (GLAIF) was established to help public authorities in the delivery of commitments in their Gaelic Language Plans, and in support of the National Gaelic Language Plan. GLAIF has also been used to assist other public authorities in the delivery of projects ahead of their formal notice to produce a Gaelic Language Plan.

Pròiseactan a gheibhear taic

Tha sgeama na bliadhna seo gu sònraichte ag amas air taic a chur ri buidhnean a bhios a' libhrigeadh phròiseactan a tha a' coileanadh na leanas:

- A' brosnachadh cleachdadh na Gàidhlig is a' togail comasan airson leasachadh na Gàidhlig anns a' choimhearsnachd, gu h-àraidh am measg dhaoine òga
- A' cur ri inbhe, cunbhalachd is faotainneachd na Gàidhlig tro sheirbheisean coitcheann agus conaltradh an ùghdarrais
- A' neartachadh chomasan Gàidhlig, a' cur ri mothachadh Gàidhlig agus a' cruthachadh barrachd chothroman gus Gàidhlig a chleachdadh am measg ùghdarrasan poblach agus an luchd-obrach aca
- A' brosnachadh leasachadh agus leudachadh foghlam Gàidhlig (FtG agus FLi) agus ionnsachadh na Gàidhlig do dh'inbhich
- A' toirt cothroman do dhaoine òga Gàidhlig a chleachdadh san àite-obrach is sgìlean-obrach a thogail

Projects this fund aims to support

This year's scheme would specifically like to support organisations to deliver projects that achieve the following:

- Promoting Gaelic usage and building capacity for Gaelic development in the community, especially among young people
- Promoting the status, consistency and availability of Gaelic through the general services and communications of the authority
- Strengthening the Gaelic skills, promoting awareness of Gaelic and creating more opportunities to use Gaelic among public authorities and their staff
- Promoting the development and expansion of Gaelic education (GME and GLE) and adult learning of Gaelic
- Providing opportunities for young people to use Gaelic in the workplace and to develop work skills

Co dh' fhaodas tagradh a chur a-steach?

Tha a' mhaoin seo fosgailte do gach ùghdarrais poblach/ionadail ann an Alba, le prìomhachas don fheadhainn a tha a' cur an gnìomh Plana Gàidhlig reachdail.

Tha fàilte air iarrtasan bho bhuidhnean ag obair còmhla agus bho sgoiltean no buidhnean leth-eisimeileach a tha a' cur an gnìomh plana Gàidhlig an ùghdarrais poblach/ionadail ris am buin iad.

Project Requirements

Who can apply?

This fund is open to all public/local authorities in Scotland, with priority for those who are implementing a statutory Gaelic language plan.

Joint applications are welcomed, as are applications from schools or arms-length organisations (ALEOs) that are implementing the Gaelic plan of the public/local authority to which they belong.

Clàr-ama a' Phròiseict

Bidh an sgeama a' toirt taic do phròiseactan a thòisicheas eadar 1 Lùnastal 2021 agus 31 Màrt 2022 agus a thèid crìochnachadh ro 31 Lùnastal 2022. Faodaidh sibh clàr-ama eadar-dhealaichte a mholadh ge-tà ma bhruidhneas ri oifigearan a' Bhùird ro làimh.

Ìrean taic-airgid

Faodar iarrtasan airson phròiseactan a chur a-steach airson suas ri **£25,000** agus **suas ri 80% de chosgaisean a' phròiseict**. Faodar suimeannan nas àirde iarraidh ge-tà ma bhruidhneas ri oifigearan a' Bhùird ro làimh.

Measadh an iartas

Ann a bhith a' measadh na h-iarrtasan bidh sinn a' coimhead gu sònraichte air:

- Inbhe a' phròiseict agus an tagraiche fhèin
- Cho dlùth 's a tha am pròiseact a' freagairt ri prìomhachasan na maoine
- Comas am buidheann agaibh am pròiseact libhrigeadh gu soirbheachail
- Nèart nam planaichean agaibh gus buaidh a' phròiseict agaibh a mheasadh
- Luach an airgid a tha ga shealltainn leis a' phròiseict

Project Timeframe

The fund will support projects which will start between 1 August 2021 and 31 March 2022 and will be fully completed by 31 August 2022. Alternative timetables can be proposed however if discussed with Bòrd officers beforehand.

Funding levels

Project applications may be made for up to a maximum of **£25,000** and **up to 80% of project costs**. Larger sums may be requested however if discussed with Bòrd officers beforehand.

Assessing your application

In assessing applications we will be primarily looking at:

- The quality of the project and the applicant
- How clearly the project demonstrates a connection with the fund's priorities
- The ability of your organisation to deliver the project successfully
- The strength of your plans to assess the impact of your project
- The value for money demonstrated by the project
