Gaelic Language Act Implementation Fund (GLAIF) 2021/22 Funding Guidelines

Mu dheidhinn na Maoine

Chaidh Maoin Buileachaidh Achd na Gàidhlig (GLAIF) a stèidheachadh airson ùghdarrasan poblach a chuideachadh gus na Planaichean Gàidhlig aca a chur an gnìomh agus taic a chur ris a' Phlana Cànan Nàiseanta Ghàidhlig. Tha ùghdarrasan poblach cuideachd air taic-airgid fhaighinn tro GhLAIF gus pròiseactan a thoirt gu buil mus tèid iarraidh orra gu foirmeil Plana Gàidhlig a sgrìobhadh.

Tha an sgeama cuideachd airson taic a chumail ri pròiseactan ùra is ro-innleachdail airson Adhartas nas Luaithe a dhèanamh ann an libhrigeadh [Plana Cànan Nàiseanta Ghàidhlig 2018-2023](#), gu h-àraidh le bhith a' brosnachadh co-obrachadh eadar buidhnean poblach.

About the Fund

The Gaelic Language Act Implementation Fund (GLAIF) was established to help public authorities in the delivery of commitments in their Gaelic Language Plans, and in support of the National Gaelic Language Plan. GLAIF has also been used to assist other public authorities in the delivery of projects ahead of their formal notice to produce a Gaelic Language Plan.

The fund also seeks to support new and strategic projects to help advance a Faster Rate of Progress in delivering the [National Gaelic Language Plan 2018-2023](#), particularly by promoting co-operation between public authorities.

About Bòrd na Gàidhlig

Who we are

Bòrd na Gàidhlig is the public body responsible for planning and leading the development of Gaelic language and culture in Scotland on behalf of the Scottish Government.

Our vision

That Gaelic is seen and heard on a daily basis across Scotland, such that it is widely recognised as an integral part of Scottish life and a national cultural and economic asset.

Each Bòrd na Gàidhlig funding programme is based upon the priorities as communicated in the [Bòrd's Corporate Plan 2018-2023](#), and as such it is vital that you are familiar with this plan before you submit your application.

Anns an iarrtas agaibh, tha sinn airson 's gum mìnich sibh mar a bhios am pròiseact agaibh a' freagairt air aon no barrachd air aon de na h-amasan seo, a thuilleadh air a bhith a' cumail taic ris na puingean gnìomh ann am [Plana Corporra Bòrd na Gàidhlig 2018-23](#) agus ris na h-amasan bunaiteach a tha air an ainmeachadh ann am [Plana Cànan Nàiseanta Gàidhlig 2018-23](#):

- A' toirt fàs air cleachdadh na Gàidhlig
- A' toirt fàs air ionnsachadh na Gàidhlig
- A' cur deagh ìomhaigh air adhart airson na Gàidhlig

Mar phàirt den iomairt Adhartas nas Luaithe, tha sinn airson gum bi iarrtasan a' sealltainn mar a bhios iad soirbheachail ann a bhith a' libhrigeadh phròiseactan a bhios ùr-ghnàthach agus a bhios a' feuchainn ri com-pàirteachasan a thogail le ùghdarrasan poblach eile, buidhnean agus coimhearsnachdan.

Bu chòir do dh' iarrtasan cuideachd fa-near a thoirt mar as urrainn dhan na pròiseactan aca cur ri comharrachaidhean leithid Bliadhna Cholmille 2021 agus Bliadhna Sgeulachdan na h-Alba 2022.

Projects this fund will support

This year's scheme would specifically like to support organisations to deliver projects that achieve the following:

- Promoting Gaelic usage and building capacity for Gaelic development in the community, especially among young people
- Promoting the status, consistency and availability of Gaelic through the general services and communications of the authority
- Strengthening the Gaelic skills, promoting awareness of Gaelic and creating more opportunities to use Gaelic among public authorities and their staff
- Promoting the development and expansion of Gaelic education (GME and GLE) and adult learning of Gaelic
- Providing opportunities for young people to use Gaelic in the workplace and to develop work skills

In your application we expect you to expand on how your project meets one or more of these aims, as well as how it supports the actions of [Bòrd na Gàidhlig's Corporate Plan 2018-23](#) and the core aims that are identified in the [National Gaelic Language Plan 2018-23](#):

- Increasing Gaelic usage
- Increasing the learning of Gaelic
- Promoting a positive image of Gaelic

As part of the Faster Rate of Progress initiative, we encourage all applications to identify how their projects will succeed in delivering projects that are innovative and will seek to build partnerships with other public authorities, organisations and communities.

Applications should also consider how they can contribute to local, national and international celebrations such as the Year of Colmille 2021 and the Year of Scotland's Stories 2022.

Riaghailtean airson Phròiseactan

Co dh' fhaodas tagradh a chur a-steach?

Tha a' mhaoin seo fosgailte do na h-ùghdarrasan poblach/ionadail uile, ach le prìomhachas air an fheadhainn a tha a' buileachadh Plana Gàidhlig reachdail, ag ullachadh Plana Gàidhlig reachdail, no a th' air fios fhaighinn bho Bhòrd na Gàidhlig gun tèid iarraidh orra Plana Gàidhlig reachdail ullachadh.

Tha fàilte air iarrtasan bho bhuidhnean ag obair còmhla, ach bu chòir na h-iarrtasan seo prìomh bhuidheann ainmeachadh airson a' chùmhnaint taic-airgid.

Faodaidh sgoiltean agus buidhnean leth-eisimeileach aig ùghdarrasan poblaich iarrtas a chur a-steach, ach bithear an dùil gum bi iad a' sealltainn mar a bhios am pròiseact aca a' cur ri libhrigeadh Plana Gàidhlig an ùghdarras/nan ùghdarrasan poblach leis a bheil iad.

All projects that receive support must comply at all times with laws and guidance from the Scottish Government relating to coronavirus outbreaks, and applications should consider restrictions that may be in place due to coronavirus outbreaks and explain how the project will deal with such scenarios.

In assessing your application, we will be primarily looking at:

- The quality of the project and the applicant
- How clearly the project demonstrates a connection with the fund's priorities
- The ability of your organisation to deliver the project successfully
- The strength of your plans to assess the impact of your project
- The value for money demonstrated by the project

Project Requirements

Who can apply?

This fund is open to all public/local authorities, with priority given to those that are implementing a statutory Gaelic Language Plan, preparing a statutory Gaelic Language Plan or have been notified by Bòrd na Gàidhlig that they will be asked to prepare a statutory Gaelic Language Plan.

Joint applications between organisations are welcomed, although such applications should identify a lead organisation for contractual purposes.

Schools and arms-length organisations (ALEOs) of public authorities may apply but will be expected to demonstrate how their project will implement the Gaelic Language Plan of their parent public authority/authorities.

Clàr-ama a' Phròiseict

Bidh an sgeama a' toirt taic do phròiseactan thòisicheas eadar 1 Lùnastal 2021 agus 31 Màrt 2022 agus a thèid crìochnachadh ro 31 Lùnastal 2022.

Ann an suidheachaidhean sònraichte, faodaidh iarrtas clàr-ama eadar-dhealaichte a mholadh. Feumaidh conaltradh a bhith ann air seo le oifigearan a' Bhùird agus cead a bhith air a thoirt seachad mus tèid an t-iarrtas a chur a-steach, le fianais air a' chead seo air a thoirt seachad an cois an iarrtais.

Ìrean taic-airgid

'S e £450,000 am buidseat ris a bheilear an dùil airson an sgeama seo. Faodar iarrtasan airson pròiseactan a chur a-steach airson suas ri **£25,000** agus **suas ri 80% de chosgaisean a' phròiseict**. Tha cosgaisean neo-ionmhasail ceadaichte mar phàirt de chosgaisean iomlan a' phròiseict.

Ann an suidheachaidhean sònraichte, dh'fhaodadh gum faigh pròiseactan barrachd air an ìre taice as àirde far a bheil dearbhadh ann gum faodadh buaidh ro-innleachdail no fad-ùine a bhith aig seo. Feumaidh sibh cead fhaighinn bho oifigearan Bòrd na Gàidhlig gus barrachd air £25,000 a shireadh, le fianais air a' chead seo air a thoirt seachad an cois an iarrtais.

Organisations may submit more than one project application if they wish. However, Bòrd na Gàidhlig will aim to support as wide a range of bodies across Scotland as possible. As such, any element that is required for the delivery of multiple projects (e.g. staff time) must be included proportionally in each application, whilst ensuring that there is no duplicate funding requested.

Who cannot apply?

- Individuals
- Community groups
- Charities
- Commercial or for-profit organisations
- Bòrd na Gàidhlig Delivery Partners

Project Timeframe

The fund will support projects which will start between 1 August 2021 and 31 March 2022 and will be fully completed by 31 August 2022.

In exceptional circumstances, an application may propose an alternative timeframe. This must be discussed and permitted by Bòrd na Gàidhlig officers prior to the application being submitted, with evidence of this permission provided along with the application.

Funding levels

The estimated budget allocated to this fund is £450,000. Applications may be made for up to a maximum of **£25,000** and **up to 80% of project costs**. In-kind costs are permitted as part of a contribution towards total project costs.

In exceptional circumstances, projects may be awarded more than the maximum grant where it can demonstrate potential strategic or long-term benefits. Permission to apply for over £25,000 must be obtained beforehand from Bòrd na Gàidhlig officers, with evidence of this permission submitted with the application.

Bu chòir dhuibh dèanamh cinnteach nach eil pàirt sam bith eile de bhuidseat a' phròiseict a' tighinn bho sgeamaichean maoinachaidh eile no prògraman maoinachadh cunbhalach aig Bòrd na Gàidhlig.

Cha bhi sinn a' cur taic ri cosgaisean pròiseact ri linn:

- Cosgaisean calpa
- Co-fharpaisean
- Cosgaisean luchd-obrach no ghoireasan air an cleachdadh gus curraicealam foghlam tro mheadhan na Gàidhlig a libhrigeadh
- Buanachadh dreuchdan a th' ann a-cheana nach robh a' faighinn taic tro GhLAIF (ach ma tha iad an sàs ann am pròiseact GLAIF ùr)
- Cosgaisean ann a bhith a' dealbhachadh, a' dèanamh co-chonaltradh air no a' foillseachadh Plana Gàidhlig

Gheibh tagraichean a tha soirbheachail 80% den tabhartas iomlan aig tòiseach a' phròiseict mar as àbhaist, leis an 20% mu dheireadh air am pàigheadh às dèidh aithisg dheireannach riarachail a bhith air a toirt seachad. Cha tèid a' chiad phàigheadh airson pròiseact 2021/22 a phàigheadh gus a bheil aithisgean dheireannaich airson pròiseactan cheana agus aithisgean dearcnachaidh planaichean Gàidhlig air a bhith an cur a-steach.

Riaghailtean eile

Feumaidh sibh dreach tuairisgeul(an)-obrach a chur a-steach còmhla ris an iarrtas ma tha sibh a' sireadh taic-airgid airson dreuchd, agus feumaidh Gàidhlig a bhith na sgil riatanach airson na dreuchd.

Feumaidh an tuarastal airson gach cothrom obrach air a mhaoinachadh tro GhLAIF a bhith aig ìre de cho-dhiù [Tuarastal Bith-Beò na h-Alba de £9.50 gach uair](#).

Applications looking to extend an existing project supported through GLAIF will be expected to demonstrate improvement in value for money and normalisation of Gaelic within the organisation's work over previous applications.

You must ensure that no other part of the project's budget comes from other Bòrd na Gàidhlig funding schemes or regular funding programmes.

We will not support project costs relating to:

- Capital costs
- Competitions
- Staff or resource costs used for delivering the Gaelic-medium education curriculum
- Continuation of employment positions that were not previously funded by GLAIF (unless involved in a new GLAIF project)
- Costs involved in developing, consulting on or publishing a Gaelic Language Plan

Successful applications will typically receive 80% of the total grant at the start of the project, with the final 20% payable pending submission of a satisfactory final report. The first payment of a 2021/22 project will only be payable once any final reports for pre-requisite projects and any outstanding Gaelic Language Plan monitoring reports have been submitted.

Other requirements

All projects requesting support towards funding for employment posts must include a draft job description(s) along with the application, and the position must be Gaelic-essential.

All employment opportunities funded through GLAIF must pay a minimum of the [Scottish Living Wage of £9.50 per hour](#).

Airson an sgeama seo, feumaidh sibh aithne a thoirt (nuair a tha sin iomchaidh) don taic-airgid a fhuair sibh bho Bhòrd na Gàidhlig airson a' phròiseict agaibh mar pàirt den sanasachd agaibh.

Airson tuilleadh fiosrachaidh nach toir sibh sùil air an [Stiùireadh Aithneachaidh](#) is [Stiùireadh Brann](#) air an làrach-lìn againn.

Sgrùdadh is measadh air a' phròiseact

Bidh aig gach pròiseact soirbheachail ri sgrùdadh is measadh a dhèanamh air mar a thèid am pròiseact aca a libhrigeadh agus feumaidh iad fianais a thoirt seachad air an sin ann an aithisgean adhartais agus no deireannaich aca.

Bidh aig gach pròiseact a gheibh còrr is £10,000 ri aithisg adhartais a chur a-steach ro 31 Faoilleach 2022 agus bidh aig gach pròiseact ri aithisg dheireannaich a chur a-steach.

Any application for support for a research project must be discussed with Bòrd na Gàidhlig officers before an application is submitted, with evidence of such communication submitted with the application.

For this funding programme, you must acknowledge (where appropriate) that Bòrd na Gàidhlig were a source of funding for your project as part of your publicity efforts.

Project monitoring and evaluation

All successful projects will be required to monitor and evaluate their project delivery and provide evidence of this in progress and/or final reports.

Each project that receives over £10,000 will need to submit a progress report by 31 January 2022 and all projects must submit a final report.

Applications must outline targets in their application for the project to achieve, which will be used to assess the success and effectiveness of the project.

You must also collect feedback from project participants relating to the following measures identified in [Bòrd na Gàidhlig's Corporate Plan 2018-23](#):

- “This [project/event] has encouraged me to use Gaelic more often”
- “This [project/event] has enhanced my Gaelic skills.”

Environmental impact

Bòrd na Gàidhlig recognises the risk of climate change and is trying to reduce the organisation’s impact on the environment.

We would like the organisations and projects that we fund to also consider how they can reduce their impact on the environment and in particular how they can reduce their carbon emissions.

In your application we would like you to consider the impact your project will have on the environment and how you can reduce that impact and minimise the level of carbon emissions as far as possible.

Corporate Parenting

Bòrd na Gàidhlig is legally designated as a Corporate Parent in the Children and Young People (Scotland) Act 2014. This means that we have statutory duties to fulfil with regard to enhancing the wellbeing of care-experienced young people and removing barriers to opportunities which this population often faces.

Bòrd na Gàidhlig encourage projects that we fund to provide activities designed to promote the interests and wellbeing of care-experienced young people.
